



TIPS FOR USING THE PLF WEBSITE

Oregon lawyers are always on the lookout for useful forms and checklists, publications, and CLE materials. For those with Internet access, a wealth of information awaits at the PLF website, www.osbplf.org. Visit often and get access to news, coverage information, personal management assistance, and practice management help. Download books or practice aids, search the *In Brief* newsletter archives, or order CLE audio and videotapes online. New items are added on a regular basis, including registration forms for upcoming seminars. Here are a few tips to help you get the most out of your website visit.

VIEWING AND PRINTING DOCUMENTS

Most of the content on the Web, including the PLF website, is in PDF, or portable document format. Viewing PDF files requires PDF software. Adobe offers a free program called Adobe Acrobat Reader® that will read all PDF files. Newer computers often come with this software preloaded. To download Adobe Acrobat Reader®, follow the links on the PLF website or visit www.adobe.com. (Also see *Update Your Software Regularly* for tips on upgrading your Adobe Acrobat Reader® software.)

When you access a PDF file using Adobe Acrobat Reader®, Adobe's toolbars will appear at the top of your computer screen just under your browser toolbar(s). To print a PDF file, you must use the Adobe printer icon (top toolbar, second button in, far left). Selecting File, Print from the pull-down menu in your browser won't work, nor will clicking on

the printer icon in your browser toolbar.

SEARCHING THE PLF WEBSITE

Can't find what you're looking for? Interested in related materials that might be available? Look for the search icon that appears throughout the PLF website. Search for any word, all words, or an exact phrase. Display 5, 10, 25, 50, or 100 results with or without summaries. Sort results by score (an indication of how closely they match your search term) or by date. Sound-alike matching is selected for you by default to enhance search results. Searches are *not* limited to titles, keywords, or descriptions unless you change the search settings. When you allow the search engine to look "anywhere" within the site, it will search through every word in every document to generate a list of relevant results. For example, a search for "trust deed foreclosure" anywhere in the PLF website will bring up the PLF's Trust Deed Foreclosure Checklist, other PLF forms where trust deed foreclosure is mentioned, as well as references to trust deed foreclosures in newsletter articles and the PLF's *Oregon Statutory Time Limitations* handbook. The search engine is quick, easy to use, and the best way to ensure that you have found *all* relevant content on a given subject.

UPDATE YOUR SOFTWARE REGULARLY

If you have an older version of Adobe Acrobat Reader® – 4.0 or earlier – you may experience problems viewing documents that were created with the newest versions of PDF software. Solve potential compatibility problems by downloading the most recent version of Adobe Acrobat Reader®. Version 6.0 is

available now. To keep up with future changes, allow the Reader® software to connect to Adobe's website and check for updates when prompted. (Prompts are automatic in Version 5.0 or later and come up whenever you access a PDF file.)

CURE LOG-ON PROBLEMS

Visitors to the PLF website log on by using their bar number and name. If you are having difficulty accessing the site, check your browser settings. To visit any website that uses a log-on name and password, you must allow "cookies," a small text file stored on your computer. There are several types of cookies, and you can choose whether to allow some, none, or all of them to be saved on your computer. In Internet Explorer 6, click on Tools, Internet Options...and select the Privacy tab to change your cookie settings.
